California's First Theatre

Profiled Project:



Built using lumber salvaged from a shipwreck, California's First Theatre was built in 1843 by English Sailor Jack Swan. In 1847, army officers convinced Swan to build a small stage on the property, and he then utilized the theatre to host melodramas. The First Theatre was also used as a tavern and lodging for whaling men. Upon Swan's death in 1896, the Theatre fell into disrepair and was bought by the California Historic Landmark's League in 1906, and later donated to the State of California. Spectra Company is currently in the process of restoring the historic masonry fireplaces.

L.A. "Downtown" Women's Center

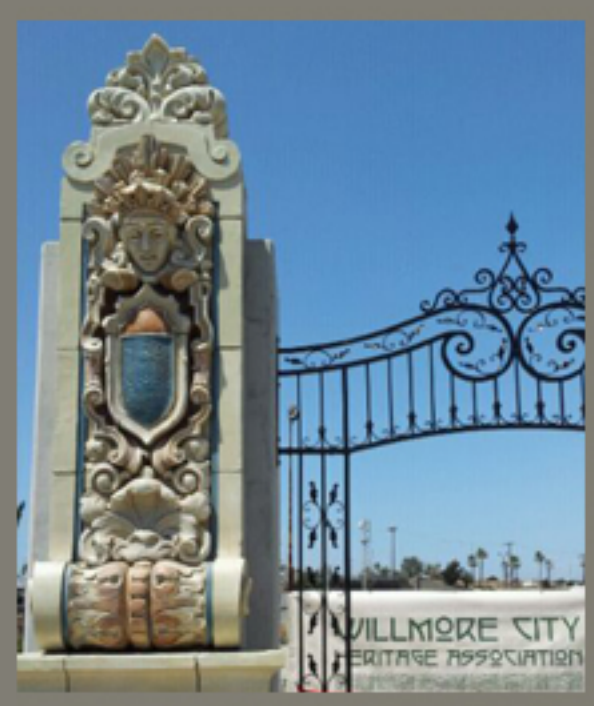
